LONDON OVERSEAS VISITS 2010 FACTSHEET

• Provisional data from the IPS shows that in 2010, London welcomed 14.6 million overseas visitors, 2.7% more than in 2009.

• This is the first increase in visit numbers since 2006, and suggests London's visitor economy is now well on the road to post-recession recovery.

• Expenditure, buoyed by the continuing weakness of sterling, reached almost £8.7 billion, a 5.2% boost over 2009.

• 50% of London overseas visitors originated from Eurozone countries, dominated by arrivals from France Germany, Spain and Italy. A further 13.4% arrived from the rest of Europe.

• North America accounted for 14.6% of London's visitor base. The USA was London's biggest single market, with 1.74m visits and £1.3 billion of spend.

• The most rapid growth (+10%) came from Asia Pacific, a market that represents about 11% of all arrivals.

• The buoyant leisure sector, accounting for one-half of international visits to London, grew by 3.2% in 2010.


• But the most notable aspect of London's visitor activity in 2010 was a return to growth for the business sector (+7.6%), in the wake of sustained losses since 2007.


• VFR arrivals are more than one-fifth of London's market. A more non-essential segment of the market, it was badly affected by the recession, but has stabilised towards the end of 2010.
